Role summary - Continuous Improvement and coordination of Y.E.S for ILG

- Assist with the review and documentation of current processes, identifying areas for improvement and build, present and drive business change with clearly defined and measurable return on investment, supporting the warehouse teams - particularly for our top 20 accounts
- Assist the ROM to work with internal stakeholders to drive process review and change demonstrating quantifiable cost-downs. For example, labour, equipment, productivity gains, Health & Safety enhancements
- Help review, research and implement solutions design and tech enhancement, clearly documenting return of investment and overall benefit
- Help conduct detailed analysis of data available from the ILG Warehouse Management System (WMS) to identify areas of opportunity
- Provide administrative support to keep CI tracker up-to-date, ensuring measurable benefit for each improvement is quantified and documented.
- Help to implement changes agreed by CAB, with in-depth audit after 3 months documenting actual vs expected return on investment
- Assist and work with Warehouse Managers, Warehouse Operations and Section Managers

- Stay ahead of CI trends within the industry by actively participating in professional associations, attending conferences, exhibitions and webinars to identify, justify and implement new processes and product offerings that yield a competitive advantage for ILG
- Help to review current IT platforms for CI and make recommendations to enhance or change software in line with ILGs growth strategy
- Work closely with ILG Commercial Team to review any client-driven changes to existing processes, assessing impact and submitting proposals for approval
- Work closely with the IT team and key IT suppliers to ensure items that require development are included with any associated roadmaps. Provide testing support where necessary to ensure new functionality is fit for purpose
- Develop an in-depth understanding of the Yusen Excellence Systems programme, how to document, communicate, liaise and update the local and central team
- Help to ensure that ILG is the leading continuous improvement area within the YLEU element of the Yusen Excellence Systems Programme
- Help the quality assessments for ILG across relevant categories of the Y.E.S programme, proactively working in conjunction with warehouse and regional managers, plus other relevant colleagues
- Assist in the coaching of Warehouse and Regional Managers to complete own quality assessments where appropriate
- Assist in the development of best practise and standardisation across all sites
- Help to develop a Kaizen/5S culture with the local operational team in conjunction with senior management team within the department

Role summary - Solutions Design

- Assist in the process of the design, reconfiguration/construction of warehouse facilities, including onsite coordination of contract installation resources
- Assist in the design of warehouse layouts and storage solutions that align with facility operational requirements
- Work with various vendors (racking, material handling equipment, labour, etc.) to help to take designs to quote and through the internal procurement process
- Help to design warehouse optimisation models for warehousing inventory capacity and inbound/outbound processing

- Maintain strong, collaborative relationships with operational team and suppliers in order to support completion of process improvements
- Maintain strong relationships with key internal stakeholders (ILG and Yusen Europe) and externally, with key systems providers as well as operational management
- Combine operational knowledge with business perspective and strong process management to deliver timely decision making and strong communication
- Bring energy, vision and passion to the organisation
- Challenge the CI champions and operations team in a constructive way, driving continued commercial performance and value-creation.
- Bring a strong team ethos within the Continuous Improvement and Operations team
- Proactively follow trends within our industry and the industries we serve to understand risks and opportunities for the business, sharing knowledge and insight within the CI and Ops team
- Working in the warehouse if required
